Aaron G. Grech is a doctorate in economics and is the Chief Economist of the Central Bank of Malta. In this capacity, he has helped develop several macro-econometric models used for forecasting and policy simulations. He has also coordinated the Central Bank's research activities, including participation in ESCB research networks, besides authoring several studies on the Maltese economy.

Dr Grech has represented the Bank on a number of ECB working groups and committees. At the same time, he is also a research fellow at the London School of Economics, where he conducted his doctoral studies with Sir John Hills, former UK Pensions Commissioner, and Prof Nicholas Barr, pension policy advisor to several governments including those of Sweden, China and Chile. Prior to joining the Central Bank of Malta, Dr Grech advised the UK government during two pension reforms and served for seven years as the UK Government's pension expert on EU and OECD committees. He has also given technical assistance on pensions to the European Commission, the OECD, the Maltese Government and the Federal Court of Auditors of Brazil. He holds economics degrees from the University of Malta, University College London and the London School of Economics. He is a member of the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Economics, Management and Accountancy of the University of Malta and is a member of the European Economic Association.
