**Dr Carl Camilleri**

Dr Carl Camilleri is a Senior Lecturer at the University of Malta within the Department of Economics (Faculty of Economics, Management and Accountancy). He is also currently the Head of the Economics Department within the same Faculty.

Over the past 15 years Dr Camilleri has primarily focused on the lecturing of Econometrics at the Department of Economics. Over the years, Dr Camilleri was also involved in the lecturing of a number of other courses, in particular: Applied Macroeconomics, Health Economics and the Economics of Ageing and Pensions at the same University. Prior to joining the Department of Economics, Dr Camilleri served in the public service within the Economic Policy Division (Ministry of Finance) for 10 years and held the position of Senior Economist within the same Division. Dr Camilleri was mainly responsible for macroeconomic forecasting and during his stay at the Economic Policy Division, Dr Camilleri was involved in the modelling and analysis of pension reform systems within the Maltese economy. Dr Camilleri is also currently serving his second term as Council Member of the Malta Fiscal Advisory Council.

Dr Camilleri holds a Master of Science degree in Econometrics awarded from Queen Mary and Westfield College (University of London) in 1999 and has been awarded the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Economics from City University (London) in 2015.
